



WSCC SUMMER FUN PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION AND INFORMATION

Dates: Week 1: June 27- July 1, 2011
Week 2: July 5 - July 8, 2011 (*no camp on Mon, July 4*)

Time: 9:00am -1:00pm (*pack a lunch*)

Early Childhood Summer Fun Program: Crafts & Games (Ages 4 to 7 years old)

Mrs. Garvey and Ms. Bullard will engage the children in craft projects, time in nature, walks, circle games, traditional games and imaginative stories. A healthy snack and drink will be served to your child mid-morning.

Please pack a healthy lunch and drink (no sweets or candy, please) for your child each day of camp (with ice pack, if necessary – no refrigeration provided).

Your child will need a sun hat, a rain coat if the weather is expected to be wet, a sweatshirt, light sweater or a long-sleeve shirt. Please apply sun screen and/or bug repellent prior to the beginning of camp. Make sure all personal items are labeled with name of child.

Grades Summer Fun Program: Handwork & Games (For rising first graders through rising seventh graders)

Join Mrs. Hopewell and Ms. Baugh for a fun-filled week of handwork and games. Younger students will spend the handwork portion of their week knitting a small stuffed animal or doll/gnome. Depending on skill level, students can choose from a variety of patterns: past projects include small chicks, elephants, gnomes, dogs and leaping cats. Older students (rising sixth graders and above) can choose to knit a project or design and create a wet-felted wall hanging.

For the games portion of the camp, students will participate in a variety of activities ranging from cooperative games to beloved traditional school-yard play such as jump rope, hop scotch, Chinese jump rope and four-square. Children who are rising fifth graders and above have the option of being part of circus arts activities which will include juggling, stilt work, devil sticks and Diablo skills.

Please pack a healthy snack, lunch and drink (no sweets or candy, please) for your child each day of camp (with ice pack, if necessary – no refrigeration provided).
