Our ideal candidate has Waldorf early childhood teaching experience, has completed or is near completing early childhood Waldorf teacher training and/or Lifeways training. We seek a colleague who is warm, flexible, has a passion for working with young children, and possesses strong communication skills.

The Siesta Program is our daily mid-day program from 12:00-3:00 that serves the children who are currently enrolled in our early childhood morning programs and wish to stay throughout the remainder of the school day. The program includes story, rest, and indoor and outdoor free play. The Aftercare Program is our after school program that runs from 3:00–5:30pm.

Our early childhood program consists of daily parent-child programs, two nursery programs for 3-5 year olds, and a kindergarten. Our Elementary and Middle School serves grades 1-8, and offers a richness of experience in both class and subjects teachers (handwork, woodwork, Latin, music, and movement and games).

Our school is located on a beautiful 13.5 acre property surrounded by woods.
